

Madison County Fair Rules and Regulations

1. Only beef heifers and steers are eligible to show. All animals must have official health papers when checked in on Friday that meet the state requirements.
2. Only current 4-H and FFA members are eligible (9 yrs. and older). Any member that has graduated from high school is not eligible to show.
3. A limit of 3 heifers and 2 steers is the maximum that a member can enter for the show.
4. All purebred animals must have registration papers in hand at time of check-in.
5. Animals must be shown by their owner unless permission is granted from the chairman of the show.
6. This is a **blow and go show**. No gluing please.
7. Animals must be brought in **Friday, September 29th** from 11:00 am until 4:30 p.m. **All animals must be in place by 4:30 p.m.** First come first serve in the barn.
8. The show will be held on **Friday, September 29th** at **7:00 p.m.**, starting with showmanship (youngest to oldest), and followed by the steer and heifer show. All cattle are released after the show.
9. All exhibitors are expected to keep a clean and neat stall area or will risk forfeiture of all prize money. Limited tack space will be provided outside of the show barn. ****Generators are not required, but are definitely recommended****
10. All breeds are eligible, including commercial heifers. However, there must be at least four animals per breed to constitute a breed show. Breeds with less than four animals will be shown in Other Breeds.
11. A \$20.00 entry fee per animal will be charged at the time of entry. Checks should be made payable to the: **Madison County Fair**.
12. Three classes of showmanship will be divided as equally as possible by grade at the discretion of the show committee.
13. **No bedding (straw or hay) will be allowed in the barn.**
14. **No head chutes are allowed in the barn. These must be set up outside of barn stall areas.**
15. All animals will be exhibited at the owner's risk. Every precaution will be taken to prevent damage to animals but neither the Fair Association nor those in charge of the show assume the responsibility in the case of loss or damage to any exhibit.
16. Show will follow state rules.

Classifications:

A. Jr. Heifer – Calved on or after January 1, 2017

B. Sr. Heifer – Calved from **Jan. 1 through Dec. 31, 2016**

C. Steers – Divided into light, medium, and heavy classes if numbers permit

**If a class has enough entries, it will be divided into two classes by the show committee.
