

Georgia Limousin Association Field Day Steer & Heifer Show

June 15th & 16th – JCCHS Livestock Facility in Jefferson, GA

1. Exhibitors must be a member of the Georgia Junior Limousin Association. Dues are \$10. Members who have reached their 22nd birthday on or before January 1, 2018, are ineligible.

The field day is open to eligible exhibitors from Georgia, Florida, Alabama, Tennessee, North Carolina and South Carolina.

2. Heifers born on September 1st 2016 and after will be eligible for entry. Lim-Flex heifers (purple papered) that are 25% to 75% and Limousin heifers (orange papered) that are 75% and above are eligible.

Cow-calf pairs will also be eligible for entry. Cows must have been born on September 1st 2014 or later. There will not be a cow-calf pair champion and reserve selected, they will compete in the female show. Pairs will have their own class in the female show.

If there are a minimum of seven Limousin and seven Lim-Flex entries we will have two separate female shows. If entries do not meet minimum requirements, Limousin and Lim-Flex females will show together.

3. This will be a prospect steer show. All steers must be registered with the North American Limousin Foundation and be 25% or greater.
4. There will be four divisions of showmanship: Novice (Pre-Club) – Junior (4th – 6th grade) – Intermediate (7th – 9th grade) & Senior (10th grade and up)
5. Bred & Owned Class: This class shall consist of heifers exhibited in the regular show that were raised by the exhibitor. In order to show in the Bred and Owned division, the heifer's herd prefix must be that of the exhibitor, and the heifer's dam must have been owned (based on NALF records) by the exhibitor at the time the dam was bred to produce the animal being shown.
6. Fitting can occur at the discretion of the exhibitor. No powders of any color, false tailheads, added hair or the addition of any hairlike substance will be allowed to be used in the fitting of either steers or heifers. Filling of steers or heifers with any substance is prohibited. Animals must be shown in their natural conformation without alteration by modification except for grooming and treatment of the hair and the trimming of hooves.
7. All exhibitors are required to show their own animals. In the case of two entries in the same class, or sickness or injury after arrival at the field day site, a substitute showman may be permitted. Substitutions must be approved by the show committee before entering the show ring.

8. Heifers must be registered in the exhibitor's name by June 1st, 2018. Exhibitor must present the original registration certificate at check in. Photocopies are not acceptable.
9. All entries must be accompanied by an interstate health certificate.
10. Check in/weigh in will occur on Friday, June 15th from 1 – 3. The barn will be open by 8:30 that morning to receive entries.
11. All exhibitors agree to abide by the show rules and to all decisions, rule interpretations, and conclusions of the show committee. Anyone failing to comply with the rules of the show will forfeit any prize money and trophies.
12. Entry fee for the show will be as follows: Georgia exhibitors must provide one auction item per animal entered. Out of state exhibitors must provide one auction item plus \$10 per animal entered.

Examples of auction items can include show supplies, farm supplies, artwork, baked goods, gift baskets or anything else that may be attractive to exhibitors, families, breeders and others.

Entry deadline will be June 6th, 2018.

13. Payout will be as follows
 - \$50 for each exhibitor – regardless of placings/entries
 - \$200 + Award – Champion Limousin/Lim-Flex Female
 - \$100 + Award – Reserve Champion Limousin/Lim-Flex Female
 - \$100 + Award – Champion Steer
 - \$50 + Award – Reserve Champion Steer
 - \$50 + Award – Champion Bred & Owned Female
 - \$25 + Award – Reserve Champion Bred & Owned Female
 - Award – Champion Showman in Junior, Intermediate and Senior DivisionsAll novice showmanship participants will receive an award and do not have to have had a calf entered in the show nor be a member of the GJLA.

Each exhibitor will also be provided with a field day t-shirt. This year's t-shirt is being sponsored by Pleasant Acres Farm.

14. The Georgia Limousin Association, nor the Georgia Junior Limousin Association will be responsible for any accident that may occur to the animal(s) and/or exhibitor(s).
