

Madison County Fair Rules and Regulations

1. Only beef heifers and steers are eligible to show. All animals must have official health papers when checked in on Friday that meet the state requirements.
2. Only current 4-H and FFA members are eligible (9 yrs. and older). Any member that has graduated from high school is not eligible to show.
3. A limit of 3 heifers and 3 steers is the maximum that a member can enter for the show.
4. All purebred animals must have registration papers in hand at time of check-in.
5. Animals must be shown by their owner unless permission is granted from the chairman of the show.
6. This is a **blow and go show**. No fitting please.
7. Barn opens **Friday, September 25th** from 11:00 am until 4:00 p.m. **All animals must be in place by 4:00 p.m.** (Check-in from 2:00 pm to 4:00pm).
8. **There will be stall assignments due to Covid-19 with spaces left between counties. Do NOT use this space for tack.** Tack space will be outside the barn.
9. The show will be held on **Friday, September 25th** at 6:00 p.m., starting with showmanship (youngest to oldest), and followed by the heifer and steer shows. All cattle are released after the show.
10. **Due to limited space, once the barn reaches capacity all other entries will be returned.**
11. All exhibitors are expected to keep a clean and neat stall area or will risk forfeiture of all prize money. Limited tack space will be provided outside of the show barn. ****Generators are not required, but are definitely recommended****
12. All breeds are eligible, including commercial heifers. However, there must be at least four animals per breed to constitute a breed show. Breeds with less than four animals will be shown in All Other Breeds.
13. A \$20.00 entry fee per animal will be charged at the time of entry. Checks should be made payable to: **Madison County Fair**.
14. Four classes of showmanship will be divided as equally as possible by grade at the discretion of the show committee.
15. **No bedding (straw or hay) will be allowed in the barn.**
16. **No head chutes are allowed in the barn. These must be set up outside of barn stall areas.**
17. All animals will be exhibited at the owner's risk. Every precaution will be taken to prevent damage to animals but neither the Fair Association nor those in charge of the show assume the responsibility in the case of loss or damage to any exhibit.
18. Show will follow state rules.
