Rules and Regulations

- 1. Youth must be in good standing with 4-H or FFA.
- 2. Recommended that Steers are born after September 1, 2019.
- 3. Heifers must be born after January 1, 2019.
- 4. Steers will be shown by weight. A top 3 will be selected.
- 5. Each calf must be accompanied by a valid set of health papers.
- 6. Fitting is optional.
- 7. All exhibitors must show their own calves in the showmanship competition. Age is based on on the exhibitors age as of July 1, 2020.
- 8. Junior (9-11), Intermediate (12-14), Senior (15-18)
- 9. Entries must be postmarked by September 1, 2020. Entries received after that date will have a \$20 late fee per calf applied.
- 10. Must have 5 calves to make breed or will fall into AOB.
- 11. Heifers will be shown by DOB with the exception of commercial which will be shown by weight.
- 12. All heifers/steers must be shown in their natural conformation and structure without alteration by modification except for the grooming and treatment of the hair and trimming of the hooves. No graphite, hair, cotton twine, etc. may be applied.
