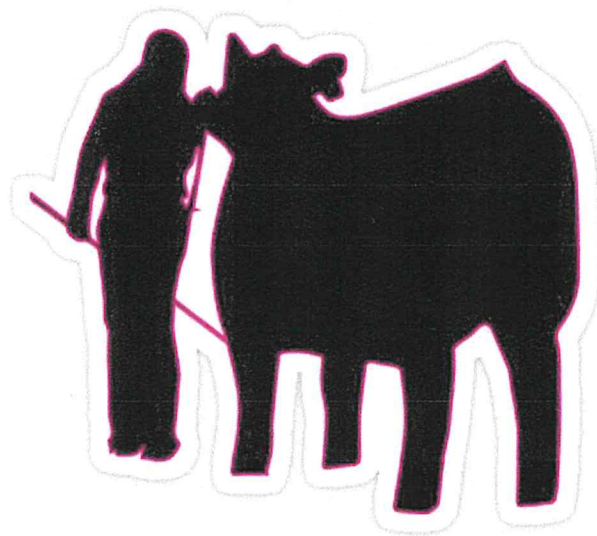

Rules and Regulations

- All animals must be checked in and weighed between before 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 30, 2021. Show will begin at 11:00am.
- All exhibitors will show according to their current grade in school. This show is open to anyone still in high school or younger from any state.
- Commercial Heifers and Market Heifers/Market Steers will be shown by weight.
- Heifers can be double registered as commercial and market.
- Registered heifers will be shown by age.
- Registered breeds must have seven (7) head in each class to show; otherwise, they will be shown in the "All other Breeds" (AOB) category.
- All steer classes will be established by weight.
- There will not be a weight limit.
- All entries must have a form of identification (tattoo, brand and/or tag ID).
- There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor.
- The Heifer Show will begin immediately after Showmanship has concluded.

Showmanship

- Pee-Wee: 3rd and below
- Juniors: 4th-6th grade
- Intermediate: 7th-9th grade
- Senior: 10th-12th grade

Health Certificates All animals must have an official health certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian at time of check-in. Animals must be free of lice and are subject to the health requirements of the State of Georgia

Interpretation of Rules Show management reserves the right to amend, add to and interpret the rules and regulations as set forth. The Show Committee has final decision-making privileges over all show rules.
