Rules and Regulations

- All animals must be checked in and weighed between the hours of 8:00-10:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 2, 2021. Show will begin at 11:00am.
- All exhibitors will show according to their age on August 1, 2021. This show is open to anyone 18 years old and younger from any state.
- Commercial Heifers, Market Heifers/Market Steers and commercial bulls will be shown by weight.
- There will be no re-weighing once an animal has left the scales.
- There will not be a weight limit.
- All entries must have a form of identification (tattoo, brand and/or tag ID).
- There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor.
- Wash racks are available.
- The barn is for staging and the main arena only.
- Generators are strongly recommended.
- Due to limited electrical outlets and the limitations on them, it is recommended that each exhibitor provide their own means of power for cooling and grooming of animals.
- Concessions will be onsite, breakfast and lunch/dinner.

Showmanship

- Pee-Wee 7 & Under
- Juniors: 8-11
- Intermediate: 12-14
- Senior: 15-18
- Grand Champions in Junior, Intermediate, and Senior will receive a belt buckle.

Heifers

- Heifers should not be more than three (3) years of age.
- The Heifer Show will begin immediately after Showmanship has concluded.
- Registered heifers will be shown by age.
- Non-registered or commercial entries will be shown by weight as of Saturday, October 2, 2021.

- Registered breeds must have seven (7) head in each class to show; otherwise they will be shown in the "All other Breeds" (AOB) category.
- It is not mandatory for heifers to be fitted for this show.

Steers

- Steers should not be more than two (2) years of age.
- All steer classes will be established by weight.
- Registered breeds must have seven (7) head in each class to show; otherwise they will be shown in the "All other Breeds" (AOB) category.
- It is not mandatory for steers to be fitted for this show.

Bulls

- Bulls should not be more than two (2) years of age.
- All bull classes will be established by age with the exception of crossbred.
- Registered breeds must have seven (7) head in each class to show; otherwise they will be shown in the "All other Breeds" (AOB) category.
- All bulls must have a nose ring with a lead attached before they enter the ring. Nose rings can be temporary or permanent.
- It is not mandatory for bulls to be fitted for this show.

Health Certificates

All animals must have an official health certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian at time of check-in. Animals must be free of lice and are subject to the health requirements of the State of Georgia.

Ethical Treatment

All animals must be treated in an ethical and humane manner. Any violation may result in the disqualification of the animal and the exhibitor.

Bedding and Clean-up

All exhibitors are expected to police their tie area and remove all trash, hay, and bedding at the conclusion of the show.

Interpretation of Rules

Show management reserves the right to amend, add to and interpret the rules and regulations as set forth. The Show Committee has final decision-making privileges over all show rules.
