You are cordially invited to attend the 14th Annual District 2 Georgia Farm Bureau Steer and Heifer Show. The show will be a one day show at the Jackson County Agricultural Facility on January 27, 2024. Check-in will be 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. Saturday morning. Barn will be open on Friday, January 26 from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. for early arrivals. Show will begin Saturday morning at 9:30 a.m. with showmanship classes.

ENTRY FEES

- * Entries are non-refundable/non-returnable.
 - Farm Bureau Members - \$25 per animal (membership must belong to the exhibitor and/or their immediate family)
 - Non-Members - \$35 per animal
- * Membership can be obtained at your local County Farm Bureau office for \$35.
 - There will be a \$10/head late fee for late entries.

SHOW ORDER:

- Showmanship (shown by grade - youngest to oldest)
- Market Beef Show - **NEW** this year (market steers & heifers will be shown by weight)
- Heifer Show (Registered will be shown by age, commercial by weight)
 - Commercial heifers can register for either the Market Beef Show or the Heifer Show, not both.
 - Divisions will be broken at the show committee's discretion.
 - Registered heifers with papers without enough entries for their own breed, will be moved into AOB and shown based on birthdate.
