South Georgia Cattle Jackpot Rules

- 1. The South Georgia Cattle Jackpot is open to any 4-H or FFA member who is currently in the 4th-12th grade.
- 2. Entries MUST be postmarked by September 7, 2024. If they are not mailed by this date you will have to call Eric Hickox at (912) 286-0935 to request to be allowed into the show.
- 3. The show is limited to 100 head of cattle. If entries exceed 100 head then the show eligibility will be determined according to the postmarked date. If the show fills up and you were not one of the first 100 head, then you will be contacted and your check will be returned.
- 4. All market animals (Heifers & Steers) will show together and be exhibited according to their weight.
- 5. The heifer show will be divided into Commercial and Registered animals. Commercial females will be shown by weight and Registered Heifers will be shown by their birth date. (If numbers allow the Registered heifers may be further divided into British & Continental cattle, or even by breeds.)
- Showmanship will be determined by the exhibitor's current grade in school. The divisions will be Junior 4th- 6th grade, Intermediate 7th 9th grade and Senior 10th 12 grades. Heats will be used to break large class numbers.
- 7. The showmanship will be a true Jackpot style contest with only one person per division winning the prize money.
- 8. The cattle age ranges should fall between September of 2022 to April of 2024.
- 9. All cattle must be clearly identified by an ear tag or readable tattoo.
- 10. All exhibits will comply with Georgia Health requirements and have current health documents to be eligible for the Show.
- 11. Exhibitors will receive prize money and prizes based on placings and availability of funds.
- 12. Concession stands will be available for food on Saturday
- 13. The barn will be available on a first come first serve basis. You cannot reserve or hold any spots for anyone else who may be coming to the show. Exhibitors may have to tie to trailers if there are no spaces left in the barn
- 14. Exhibitors should be prepared to have their own tents for shade and generators on hand in the event the barn fills up prior to your arrival.
