6th Annual GCCPA Show = Success!

This was the first area wide show held at the Cloud Livestock Facility in Bainbridge, Georgia and the Bainbridge folks did put on a show! The brand new facilities could match or exceed any in the southeast or anywhere else for that matter! The Decatur County Young Farmers provided the hungry crowd with excellent brisket for the Saturday night meal. A host of Young Farmers were up and cooking all day, and their results were well worth their efforts. The concession stand was run by the Decatur County 4-H Extension Service with a lot of great help. Huge thanks to everyone who helped in the concession stand!!! During Saturday afternoon and evening, different fun events were provided such as the challenging Barn Yard Games, a cattle judging contest, a very wet and refreshing water balloon fight, and a fierce watermelon seed spitting contest. Both kids and adults had a great time playing and watching the festivities.

The judge was Mr. Adam Verner from Rutledge, Georgia. Mr. Verner is a



UGA graduate with his degree in Animal Science. He raises Gelviegh, Angus, and Balancer cattle as well as chickens, and shares a very productive hay business with his Father. Adam is an extremely busy man with a wealth of knowledge about what makes a great show calf, and we appreciate him coming to judge this show. He sorted through 63 head of cattle that were bred on Georgia farms and were products of GCCPA members. The showmanship showdown competition was just that – a great competition. The kids, even with calves being pulled out for the first time, were very confident and capable. The contest was jackpot style with 43 entries. The three age divisions were rewarded with 1st place re-

ceiving a bucket and 2nd and 3rd receiving feed pans, all with GCCPA logos on them. The three first place division winners then returned to battle for Supreme and Reserve Supreme Champions.

GCCPA helps sponsor the 4th Annual Beef Industry Scholarship Challenge

The fourth annual Beef Industry Scholarship Challenge was held June 7, 2008 at the University of Georgia's Edgar L. Rhodes Center for Animal and Dairy Science building and the Livestock Instructional Arena in Athens. Six teams from across the southeast participated in the contest.

The Beef Industry Scholarship Challenge is a unique contest that focuses on the student's knowledge and skills in all areas of beef production. Teams work through ten stations that cover many beef management practices producers face each and every day.

The Georgia Cattlemen's Association Foundation sponsored the \$3000 team scholarship for contest champion The Georgia Boys. Team members were **Chandler Akins, Bo Corbett and Stewart Harbin.**

Reserve champion team honors went to the Bartow County team. Members were **Kallie Johnson, Melissa Lance and Taylor Moore.** The Georgia Allied Industry Council sponsored the reserve team scholarship of \$2100.

The Georgia Angus Association sponsored the third place team scholarship won by Gordon County 4-H. Team members were **Matthew Darby, Jacob Holmes and Tyler Turnquist.** Each team member will receive a \$500 scholarship.

The Alabama team took fourth place team honors. Team members included **Brad Baker, Reba Hicks and James Roe.** The Georgia Cattlemen magazine sponsored the fourth place team scholarship of \$900.

The fifth place team scholarship sponsored by the University of Georgia's College

of Veterinary Medicine was won by Northeast Georgia. Team members were **Brandon Arnold, Brianna Bryant and Shelly Patton.** Each team member will receive a \$250 scholarship.

Sixth place team honors went to the LaGrange FFA team. Team members were **Laura Daniel, Glen Major and Katherine Throne.** Georgia 4-H and the Georgia FFA Association sponsored the sixth place team scholarship of \$600.

In addition to the scholarships, the teams with the top score in each station were presented a \$100 cash award.

The Georgia Club Calf Producers Association sponsored the Marketing Station at the Scholarship Challenge. This station was won by *The Georgia Boys* team.

1. Calves must be bred and born on a member's farm, or
2. Owned and born on other premises
3. Calves are eligible from the purchase of bred cows or frozen embryos only if bred cows or embryos are purchased from another GCCPA member, and the new owner shall be listed as Breeder on the GCCPA point sheet.
4. Only dues paying members are eligible to purchase tags. (Exhibitors can not pay dues and buy tags for an individual they purchase the calf from.)
